#### Scholarship Information and Application - Awards for 2011 / 2012

**\$2,000 and \$1,000 Scholarships are available** with a merit basis of award that includes an evaluation of applicant's strengths and involvements both inside and outside the classroom.

Included with each award are tickets to an ASCE CI Dinner in Sacramento scheduled on September 9, 2011 (details will be provided to winning applicants), for the winner and the winner's professor.

#### Rules for the 2011 / 2012 Scholarship Application

- 1. Enrollment in a Civil / Construction Program as a Junior or First-Year Senior within the San Francisco and Sacramento ASCE Section boundaries to also include Cal-Poly San Luis Obispo and University of Nevada, Reno.
- You must submit a one page essay competition Topic: "My Future in Construction."
- You must submit biographical information and including a summary of extracurricular activities.
- 4. You must submit transcripts (unofficial transcripts from college websites are acceptable).
- 5. You must submit and sign your application.
- 6. Applications must be submitted by EMAIL and received before the deadline (late applications will not be considered). Deadline is August 5, 2011 at 5:00 p.m. (PST).

(The formal application and submittal of the above items is summarized below in the Application Process).

The ASCE Construction Institute Scholarship Directors will notify recipients by October 15, 2009. Recipients will be introduced and will receive their scholarship recognition at the ASCE CI Dinner in Sacramento scheduled for late October 2009 (details will be provided to winning applicants).

The Scholarship Awards will be deposited to the Awardees' account with the Financial Aid office of his or hers Educational Institution. Awardees must be U.S. Citizens or Legal Residents and must furnish their Social Security number.

#### **Evaluation Process**

All scholarship applications are evaluated by the ASCE Sacramento and San Francisco Section Construction Institute Scholarship Committee, which then makes it scholarship award recommendations to the CI Chapters Board of Directors. The Board approves all scholarships awarded. The decisions of the Sacramento and San Francisco Board of Directors are final.

#### **Application Process**

- Verify that you submit a complete application (10 items as required on page 2 of this document).
- Essays MUST be submitted. Any application submitted without an essay will be disqualified. Presentation (neatness, readability, grammar) does matter!
